

OVERVIEW

The new curriculum changes to the ELPP was driven by demands from current and past ELPP students and their supervisors to match the course content to the current needs of students pursuing their Master and PhD at Universiti Malaya. Thus, the new ELPP focusses on the skills of speaking and writing for academic purposes and stresses on grammar and vocabulary to reinforce speaking and writing skills.

COURSE COMPONENTS

These include all four language skills, as below:

- Speaking
- Writing
- Reading
- Listening

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The main objective is to enhance proficiency in the English language so that course participants can communicate more effectively in this language for the fulfillment of their various needs, specifically:

- For social interaction with people who use the English language
- To pursue academic activities conducted in the English language
- To be better prepared for taking English language examinations that form part of international study prerequisites (such as IELTS and TOEFL)
