UM's Bachelor of Accounting (BAcc) programme is recognized both nationally and internationally. The programme is recognised under Schedule 1 Accountants Act 1967. Graduates of this programme are eligible to register as members of the Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA), subject to three years practical accounting experience, as stipulated in Part IV of the Accountants Act 1967. INTAKE SCHEDULE

The academic programme follows the semester system and commences in September (for Semester 1). The minimum period of study is 8 semesters and the maximum period of study is 12 semesters.

Entry Requirement

A Malaysian candidate who wishes to pursue a programme of study at the University of Malaya must fulfil the University's entry requirements as follows:

(A)	Passed the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) with a credit (Grade C) in Bahasa Melayu/Bahasa Malaysia subject or a credit (Grade C) in Bahasa Melayu/Bahasa Malaysia July paper and pass in History; and
(B)	Achieve a minimum Band in the Malaysian University English Test (MUET) as required in special requirements of the programme. and
(C)	Fulfilled any of the programme Special Entry Requirements as listed below.

STPM (Current Year) - Science and Arts Stream

- Passed the STPM with at least CGPA 3.30; and
- Obtained at least Grade B+ at the STPM level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Accounting
- Mathematics M / Mathematics T
- Economics Business Studies

- PhysicsChemistry; and
- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics and pass in English Language at SPM level; and

 - Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET; and
- Passed the interview

MATRICULATION/ FOUNDATION - Science and Accounting Stream

- Passed the Matriculation / Foundation with at least CGPA 3.30; and
- Obtained at least Grade B+ at the Matriculation/ Foundation level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- AccountingMathematics

- EconomicsBusiness Studies
- Physics
- Chémistry

- Financial Accounting
- Management Accounting; and
- Obtained at least **Grade B+** for Mathematics and pass in English Language at SPM level; and

REQUIREMENT 1

- ossess a Diploma in Accounting or any related field from any institution recognized by the Government of Malaysia and approved by the University's Senate with at least CGPA 3.30; and
- Obtained at least **Grade B+** at the Diploma level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Accounting
- Mathematics
- Economics
- Business Studies
- Physics
- Chemistry
- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics pass in English Language at SPM level; and
 Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET;
- and
- Passed the interview

OR

REQUIREMENT 2

- Passed STPM not in current year with at least CGPA 3.30 and obtained at least Grade B+ at the STPM level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Accounting
- Mathematics (M)/Mathematics (T)
- Economics
- Business Studies
- Physics
- Chemistry

and

- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics pass in English Language at SPM level; and
- Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET and
- Passed the interview

OR

- <u>REQUIREMENT 3</u> Passed the Matriculation/ Foundations not in current year with at least CGPA 3.30 and obtained at least **Grade B**+ at the Matriculation/ Foundations level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- AccountingMathematics
- Economics
- Business StudiesPhysics
- Chemistry
- Accountant in BusinessFinancial Accounting
- Management Accounting;

and

- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics pass in English Language at SPM level; and
- Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET and
- Passed the interview

OTHER REQUIREMENTS - A-Level, AUSMAT and IB

- REQUIREMENT 1
 Passed the GCE A-Level with at least Grade B in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Accounting
- Mathematics
- Economics Business Studies
- Physics
- Chemistry

and

- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics pass in English Language at SPM level; and
- Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET

However, applicants who do not have MUET but have the following results may be considered for conditional offer by fulfiling the MUET requirements within the duration of one

- (1) academic session:Obtained at least Band 4.5 in IELTS (Academic)
- Obtained score of at least 477 (PBT)/153 (CBT) / 53 (IBT) in TOEFL.
- Passed the interview

NOTE: Candidates may apply using Advanced Subsidiary (AS) examination results. A-Level examination results should be submitted later once it has been obtained.

OR

REQUIREMENT 2

- Possess the Australian Matriculation programme (AUSMAT) with a minimum Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) rank of **80 percent (%)**; and
- Obtained at least 70 percent (%) score at the AUSMAT level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Mathematics
- Business Management and Enterprise
- Economics
- Accounting and Finance Physics
- Chémistry
- and - Obtained at least **Grade B**+ for Mathematics pass in
- English Language at SPM level; and
- Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET

However, applicants who do not have MUET but have the following results may be considered for conditional offer by fulfiling the MUET requirements within the duration of one (1) academic session:

- Obtained at least Band 4.5 in IELTS (Academic)

or

- Obtained score of at least 477 (PBT)/153 (CBT) / 53 (IBT) in TOEFL;

and Passed the interview

OR

- REQUIREMENT 3
 Possess the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) with a minimum score of 35 points and
- Obtained grade 5 (Higher Level) at the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) level in two (2) of the following subjects:
- Mathematics
- Economics
- Business Studies
- PhysicsChemistry
- and
- Obtained at least Grade B+ for Mathematics pass in English Language at SPM level; and
- Obtained at least Band 3 in MUET

However, applicants who do not have MUET but have the following results may be considered for conditional offer by fulfiling the MUET requirements within the duration of one (1) academic session:

- Obtained at least Band 4.5 in IELTS (Academic) or
- Obtained score of at least 477 (PBT)/153 (CBT) / 53 (IBT) in TOEFL. and

- Passed the interview
